EXPRESS ROUTE RUNS DAILY

Monday- Friday
From 8:00am- 4:00pm

GENERAL INFORMATION

Fare- \$1.00 every time you get on the bus
Seniors 60 and over, disabled riders, or persons w/ Medicare cards the fare is .50¢.
Children ages 4 and under are free. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

***Drivers Cannot Give Change**
Please, pay exact fare when boarding.

Route will not run on the following:
New Years Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and the day after ("Black Friday"), Christmas Eve, Christmas Day.

You must be able to carry on your packages. Please sit with your bags. All items must fit in your seat with you. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. No eating, drinking or smoking on the bus.

For safety reasons strollers/carriages/ shopping carts are not permitted on our buses

Always be ready 5 minutes prior to the bus arrival time.

Starting May 10, 2010, we have expanded and improved our "Express Route". In addition to Shoprite, Stop and Shop and Walmart, the express now goes to North Main St. in Monroe and the Village of Harriman. We offer quicker trips to and from Woodbury Commons, Kohl's, the Millpond area and the Village of Monroe. Our express route runs more frequently, and offers more options for our residents to move around.

- You never have to call. Just be in any safe place along route and flag down the driver
- Look for the red sign- "Monroe Express Route"
