Others present were Mary Bingham Planning Board Chair Cliff Berchtold Monroe Woodbury Transportation, Jerry Jacobowitz, Village of Harriman Mayor Steve Welle, and Trustees Ed Shuart and Bruce Chichester.

Cliff Berchtold stated that he would be happy to see the road go through and spoke to the Board on the issues with the school buses in that area due to the road being one-way.

Mary Bingham spoke about the Monroe properties on that road that can only come in one way and to attract ratables is you need to provide service.

Councilman Doles stated that he spoke with John Karl and he is concerned about the use of salt only and would like to see a salt sand mix for the roads, there are aquifers in the area that need to be protected.

Supervisor Leonard stated that we can review the salt use policy, but residents must beware that the roads will not be black and bare with the use of sand or a salt sand mix.

Mayor Welle stated that they were not informed of the meeting until the day before from Councilman Doles. He would have liked to have had the opportunity to notice this meeting for the residents of the Village of Harriman.

With no further business, on a motion by Councilman Doles, seconded by Councilman Rogers the meeting was adjourned carried unanimously.
